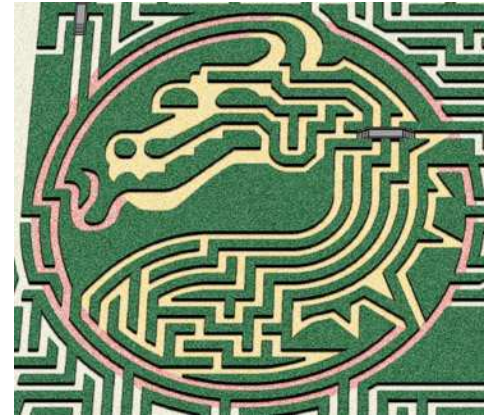

MAIZE QUEST OPENS CHINA; FORBIDDEN CITY  
CORNFIELD MAZE PLUS TWO MORE ATTRACTIONS

New Park, PA – (Aug 2008) What do you know about China? Brush up on your Chinese knowledge before the Olympics. Maize Quest's 2008 adventure season opens with its signature cornfield maze. This year guests explore China: Forbidden City.



The maze is carved into a nine-acre cornfield on Maple Lawn Farms and features educational games, 'magic' picture finds, and a secret map decoder. The goal is to escape the "Dragon". The Dragon's head covers four-acres with twisting paths shaped like his teeth and tongue.

"With the approaching Olympic games, this is a great time to get kids interested in learning about China," says Hugh McPherson, Maize Quest's Maze Master. "We've made the maze a real challenge. The information is fun for families and rich enough for school groups."

The Maze Masters added two new attractions, Perilous Planks and the Pyramid Puzzler. Perilous Planks features "tipping bridges" that tip as guests walk them. The bridges reset behind the guests creating a one-way element to the maze. Pyramid Puzzler is a color-coded pyramid with different instructions as guests step onto different colors. Guests try to get to the top level following the rules.

The new China Cornfield Maze headlines over 20 attractions in the Maze Fun Park including the 80-footlong-tube-slide, indoor playground, Bamboo Forest, and Cooling Mist Maze. Maple Lawn Farms features pick-your-own peaches, a farm market and bakery, and a view of four counties from the top of "Maze Mountain."

"After you challenge the mazes you can cool off in our newly rebuilt Mist Maze," says McPherson. "You don't have to drive far for fun. Maize Quest offers family-friendly entertainment close to home, as affordable than the movies, and more attractions for the price than any one place in Central Pennsylvania. Right here in York."

The China corn maze opens with a preview weekend Aug 2-3, 2008, then opens for the season every weekend Fri-Sat 10AM-6PM, Sun 1-7PM. Admission to the Fun Park & corn maze is \$9 adults and \$7.50 kids (2-12yrs). Group discounts for schools, scouts, and birthday parties are available. Directions- **From Bel Air / Harford County:** Follow RT 24 North to end at PA RT 851. Turn Left on RT 851W go 2 blocks to 4-way Stop. Turn Right on Market St., go 3 miles to Stop sign. Turn Right on New Park Rd, go 1/2 mi. **From Baltimore or York** 13 miles east of Interstate 83, PA Exit 4. Take Route 851 East for 10 miles through Stewartstown to New Park. At the stop sign, turn left onto New Park Rd. and bear left after one block to stay on New Park Rd. The Maze Fun Park is 4 miles on the right.*
